




Installation

- 1. The first roll is installed across purlins or girts, with the 6" tab as the leading edge.
- 2. Stretch material tight so that no sags exist and appearance is smooth and wrinkle free.
- 3. It is recommended that the roll be secured at each end with double stick tape, glue, clamps, or other method.
- 4. The next roll is installed with the trailing edge (no tab) nested tightly against and over leading edge tab from first roll.
- 5. Position and secure second roll.
- 6. Repeat the process for remaining roof or wall area.



Facing tabs can be ordered for left or right side. Right-hand tab is standard when no preference is specified.





Right-Hand Tab

Option for tape tabs (double-stick tape pre-applied to the tabs) available.

Common Applications

Roof - When Unrolling, Roll Down From Ridge or High Eave





Roof - When Unrolling, Roll Up From Low Eave





Wall - When Unrolling, Roll Down from Top of Wall
